



Instructions for application

Removable Adhesives



Your **STICK ON STICK OFF** wall adhesive can be repositioned as often as you want without getting deformed or damaging your wall. Made in Vinyl, your PLAGE adhesive is really simple to use. Like all Vinyl adhesives, it can be sensitive to some external factors.

Thus we advise you to follow the user instructions illustrated below in order to preserve the adhesive capacity of your motif for a long time.



1. Flatten your adhesive

Your adhesive should be flat before being installed

Take out the adhesive sheet from the box.

It will be rolled up due to the packaging shape.

The adhesive should not be installed immediately : it has to be flattened first to remove the folds.



2. Acclimatize your adhesive to the room

Your adhesive has to adapt to room temperature for 24hrs before being positioned

Once the sticker sheet has been smoothed out, cover it with a large book to force it to flatten.

Then wait 24hrs, this is the time needed for your adhesive to adapt to the temperature of the chosen room.

① a stable temperature between 18 and 25 degrees is the best for a firm hold of your adhesive
A thermal shock could make the adhesive come off.

② the "Stick on Stick off" can be applied in a bathroom, the glue resists humidity.
Position it on a smooth, clean and dry wall, and aerate the room regularly.



3. Clean your surface

The chosen surface should be smooth, clean and dry

The wall must be clean. Dust and micro-particles can clog up the glue and lower its adherence.

Clean your surface with water: remove all dust, grease, plaster particles, finger prints...

Then dry your surface with a cloth.



4. Test your surface

With an offcut of the adhesive sheet or the miniature design

Cut a small piece of the adhesive sheet free of the design or with the miniature design. Peel the protective film and stick the adhesive on the chosen surface. Wait for 24 hours.

Observe the result:

- If the adhesive sticks, you can position the entire design on the tested surface,
- alternatively, test another smooth, clean and dry surface.



① Smooth, clean and dry surfaces are best for a firm hold of the adhesive.

Avoid raised, very granular or silicone surfaces that lower the adherence of the design.

② Do not stick your adhesive on or above a source of heat.



① Tips for application:

No bubbles, no marks, 100% success

No risk of mess or errors in applying: thanks to the "Stick on Stick off" technology, the application is 100% successful!

If 2 pasted sides stick to each another, Peel them off gradually and carefully from each end and separate them.

If one pasted side gets stuck onto the printed side, Peel it off by pulling gradually and carefully without any risk of spoiling the print.



5. Applying small designs

Simply child's play!

Peel a motif from the adhesive sheet and place it on the chosen spot.

Then press the whole design on the surface, paying close attention to the ends by pressing with the finger tips.

Do the same with the other motifs of the sheet.

6. Applying a big design

For a simplified application



① Tip: cut the different parts of the giant adhesive

You can easily manipulate the different pieces

To apply a big design easily, you can separate the different parts of the design by cutting the sheet between the pre-cut pieces.

To evaluate the place that your design is going to take, refer to the packaging on which the dimensions of the assembled product are found (complete visual), and stick the adhesive directly, OR temporarily fix the pieces of the adhesive sheet on your surface to visualize the result.



6. Peel the design from the sheet from one edge

To roll it out gradually and easily on the surface

Make the sheet flat and carefully peel the edge from the biggest design or from the one which is numbered 1 on the sheet.

Stick this end of the design on the wall.

With one hand, slowly pull the protective film in order to roll out the adhesive, with the other hand, press the adhesive on the wall.



7. Removing the air bubbles

It is very important for the firm hold of the adhesive

Once the adhesive has been applied, it is necessary to press on the whole design with the help of a soft cloth.

The less the surface is smooth, the more the room is cold, the more the design has to be pressed!



Press on the borders of the design by using one corner of the cloth or your finger.

If the entire pasted surface of the design is not directly in contact with the surface, one part of the adhesive can peel off and, due to its weight, can drag down the whole design which will then completely peel off.



8. Verify how well the adhesive holds

A few hours after installation

Press on the whole design with a soft cloth to verify that the entire surface of the adhesive is stuck to the surface correctly.



9. Reposition the design

To change the decoration as often as you want!

Nothing could be easier!

With the "Stick on Stick off", you can peel off and re-stick the design at the time of positioning and even several months after installation!



TIPS FOR USE



① Store your "Stick on Stick off" adhesive

For a next use

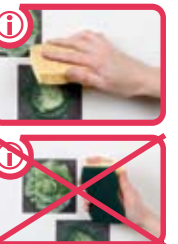
Reposition your "Stick on Stick off" adhesive on its original sheet and keep it for the next use! Then clean your surface with a sponge. Dry it: it is ready to welcome another "Stick on Stick off" design!

① Clean your adhesive

With the help of a soft sponge, carefully rub the design.

Important :

Do not use any abrasive products or materials. Then dry with a soft cloth.



? Difficulties that could be encountered

1. My design is peeling off in one place

- Have you flattened it for 24 hours?

The adhesive sheet often takes the shape of the packaging and reproduces it on the wall, if you have not taken the precaution of acclimatizing it to the temperature of the room for 24 hours. See points 1 and 2

- Have you applied the entire design on your surface?

At the time of installing, some parts of the design might not have been stuck to the surface. To solve this, once again press the whole design on your surface with the help of a soft cloth by pressing longer on the part that peeled off. See point 7

2. My adhesive has fallen off

- It is possible that it peeled off in one place. The weight of the part peeled off would have then gradually made the entire adhesive peel off and fall.

Check whether or not there is any dust on the pasted side. Then stick it back on the sheet and flatten it out for 24 hours. Then re-stick it on your surface by pressing on the entire design and its borders for a long time. See point 7

- Is the surface smooth enough?

If not, you can strengthen the adherence of your adhesive with a repositionable glue spray for example, or fix your design permanently with wallpaper glue.
